## |nstructions

1. Cut Ribbon to desired length, making a straight cut across the end.

2. Fold the last $1 / 2$ inch of the ribbon in half lengthwise, and stitch the selvedge edges together for about $1 / 4$ inch. Do not cut the thread. Take the needle down through the tunnel just created and out the end of the ribbon.

3. String beads in the following order:
a. One small, clear lily, FACEUP (put needle into the wide end, first)
b. The big faceted crystal
c. One small, clear lily, facedown (put needle into the narrow end first)
d. $\mathbf{1 5}$ seed beads ( $\mathbf{2 0}$ on strand\#2, and 26 on strand \#3)
e. One large green leaf
f. One large orange lily
g. One small orange lily
h. $\mathbf{3}$ seed beads to act as stoppers

4. Skipping the stopper beads, go back up through all the beads just stranded and emerge out of the top of the FACEUP lily.


5. String one seed bead. Begin the next strand.

6. Go back down through the clear lily, faceted crystal and clear lily. You will emerge where the seed beads began, on strand one.

7. REPEAT steps 3.d. through step 4 twice, changing the number of seed beads on each strand.


After step 4 the thread emerges through the FACEUP clear lily.

8. Stitch through the ribbon as close to the FACEUP clear lily as you can.

9. String one small, orange lily and 3 stopper beads. Skipping the stopper beads, go back through the small orange lily and the ribbon.
10. Repeat step 9 for four more orange lilies, neatly circling the ribbon right at the base. Take a couple small, unobtrusive stitches through the ribbon. Finish off the thread.
